This past school year was tough. We had planned for what we knew. We knew that Kim would be transitioning off the board after twelve years, seven as Board Chair. Creative engagement is the foundation for a meaningful path forward at Stevens, focused on action and delivering concrete evidence of impact, while also acknowledging the real need for healing and rebuilding trust among our BIPOC members. We shall remain steadfast in our commitment to continue to build capacity and hold ourselves accountable for achieving something greater on this critical front together.

As we write this last Annual Report letter together, we are incredibly hopeful for the coming year. We will come together again, and we will be a closer community and more resilient because of what we have been through together. The support from our families is what will keep making Stevens stronger!

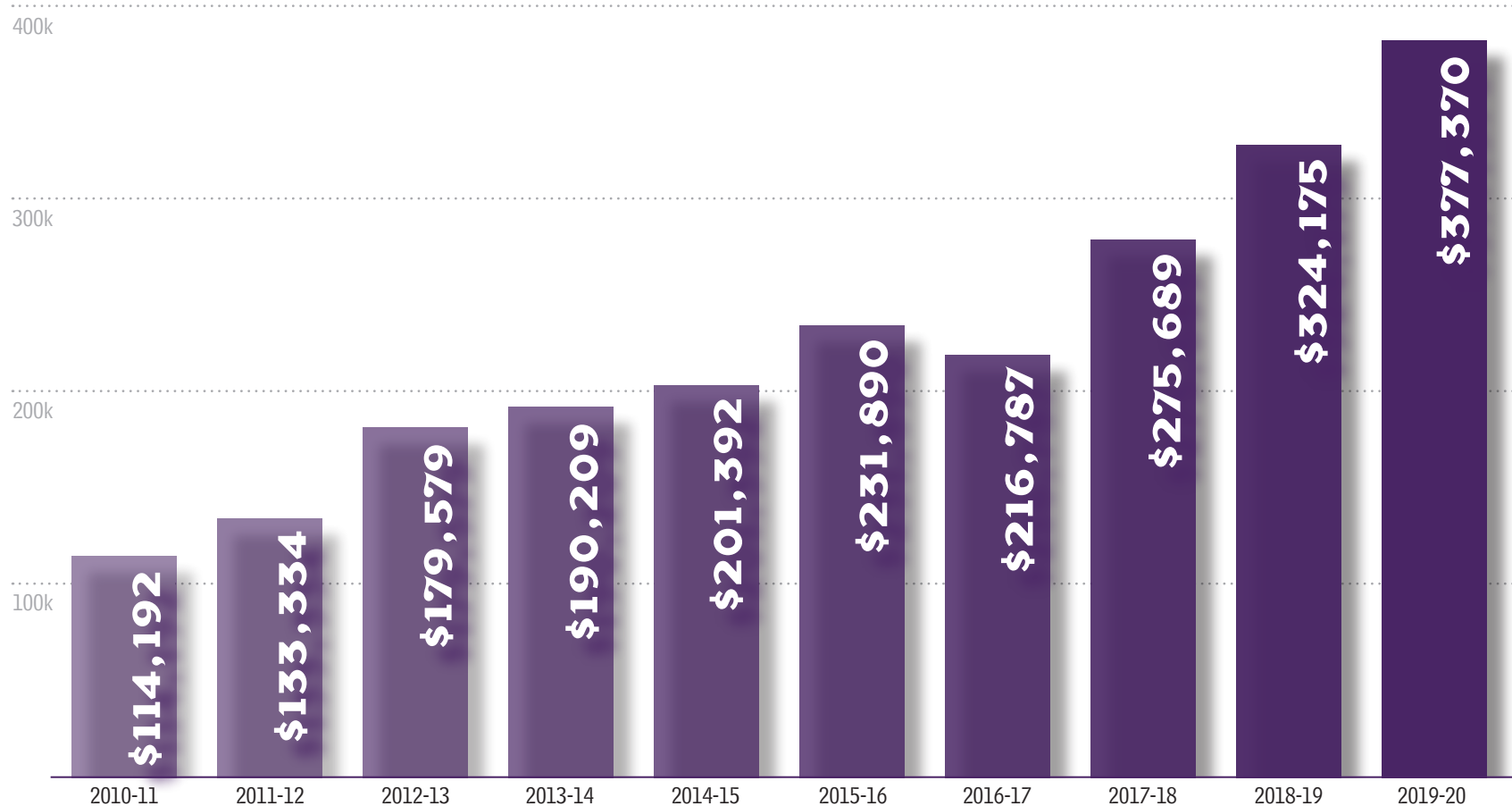

In the last ten years, giving to the Annual Fund has increased by 230% or \$263,178

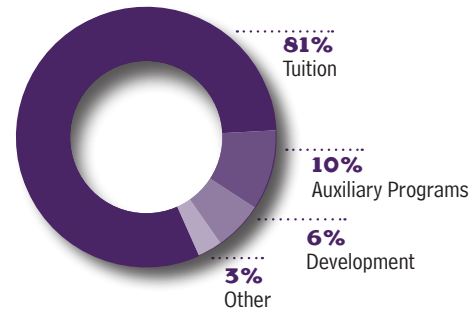
In the last three years, Parent Giving has increased by 13%

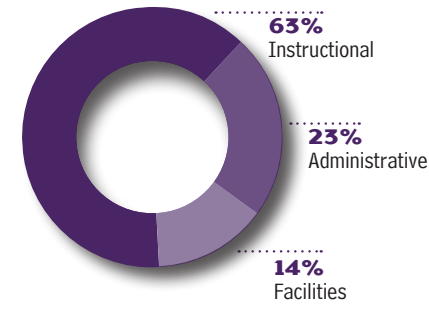
2019-2020 Income and Expenses*

Revenue



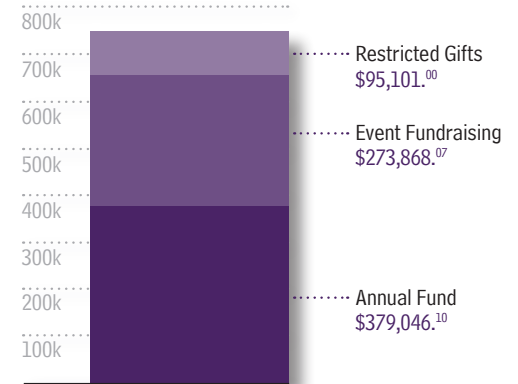

Hello!

As we reflected on the message we wanted to convey in our Annual Report letter, we kept coming back to our community. At Stevens, we talk about our community a great deal, and the Advancement Office works very hard to create events that bring us together united by our mission. However, never has the power, impact, and meaning of community been more evident in our cooperative than when we all left the school buildings on Thursday, March 12, unsure when we would be back again and how we would be affected.

At that time our world had changed irreversibly, upending our sense of normalcy. Right away, we asked ourselves, what do we need to do to keep our community safe, healthy, and whole. Our Academic Team quickly pivoted to remote teaching and learning and were ready to go when we resumed classes after Spring Break. The Leadership Team took stock of what was required to move forward and address these new and pressing demands that we could never have imagined even a week earlier. We secured resources to ensure we had what was needed to continue.

Suddenly, a community accustomed to seeing and socializing with each other daily was now in isolation. We knew that we needed each other, the urgent need for a connection was and still is very important to all of us. Families started asking how they could support the School and those affected by the pandemic. We began to find ways to connect virtually, a Zoom show with an Illusionist, a virtual get together for 8th-grade parents and guardians with a Mixologist, and one-on-one check-in meetings with families. It was amazing how quickly we were all able to adapt to this new virtual world. We hosted one of the highest attended Membership Meetings, created video content to share with students during Spirit Week, and at our virtual Milestone Event, virtual Board Meetings, our Journey celebrations, and internal planning sessions, there was no stopping us!

Then, this summer, the @blackatstevenscoop Instagram account presented us with a painful reckoning of past and present experiences, attitudes and practices that have inflicted harm on members of our BIPOC community. We have listened to the BIPOC community's feedback and are actively engaged in contributing to the subsequent action plan. Stevens' Advancement Office is committed to ensuring that our school can deliver the necessary resources and support to bolster diversity, equity and inclusion at our school.

All of this required us to use resources that had been allocated differently in our budget, and we knew that our commitment to diversity growth and training, technology needs, COVID-19 safety precautions, and staffing needs were only going to get larger. As always, when we asked our families for support, you were there for the School. We were able to reach our goal of \$375,000 in a time when we didn't know what to expect. Thank you!

As we continue to plan for the upcoming school year, we know that it will be anything but ordinary, but we know that together we will make it work. We will continue to be there for each other. We have worked very hard to ensure that the 2020-2021 school year is fantastic, and we thank you in advance for your ongoing support of our work.
